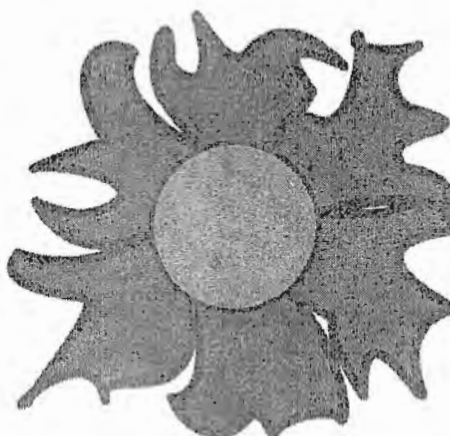

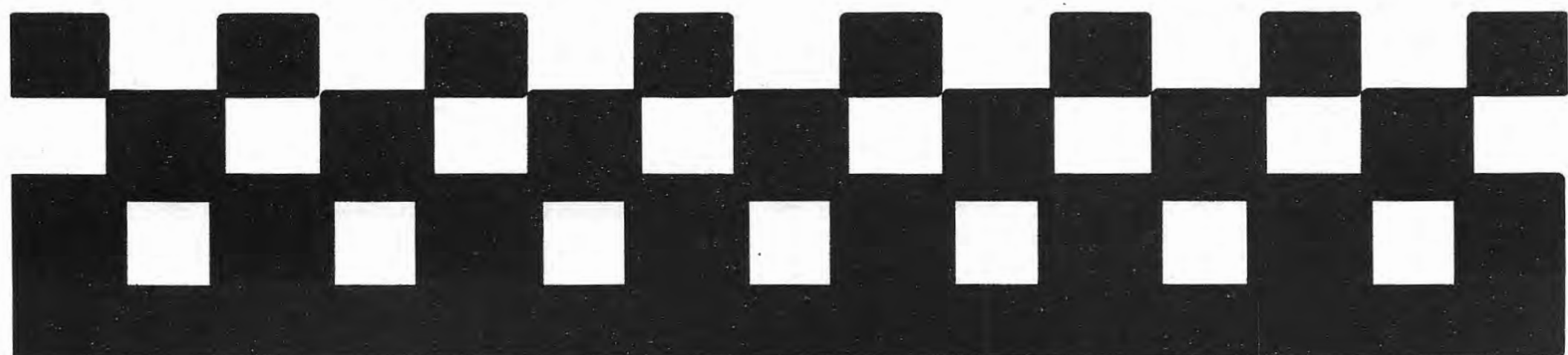
What is a Progressive Dinner You Ask?

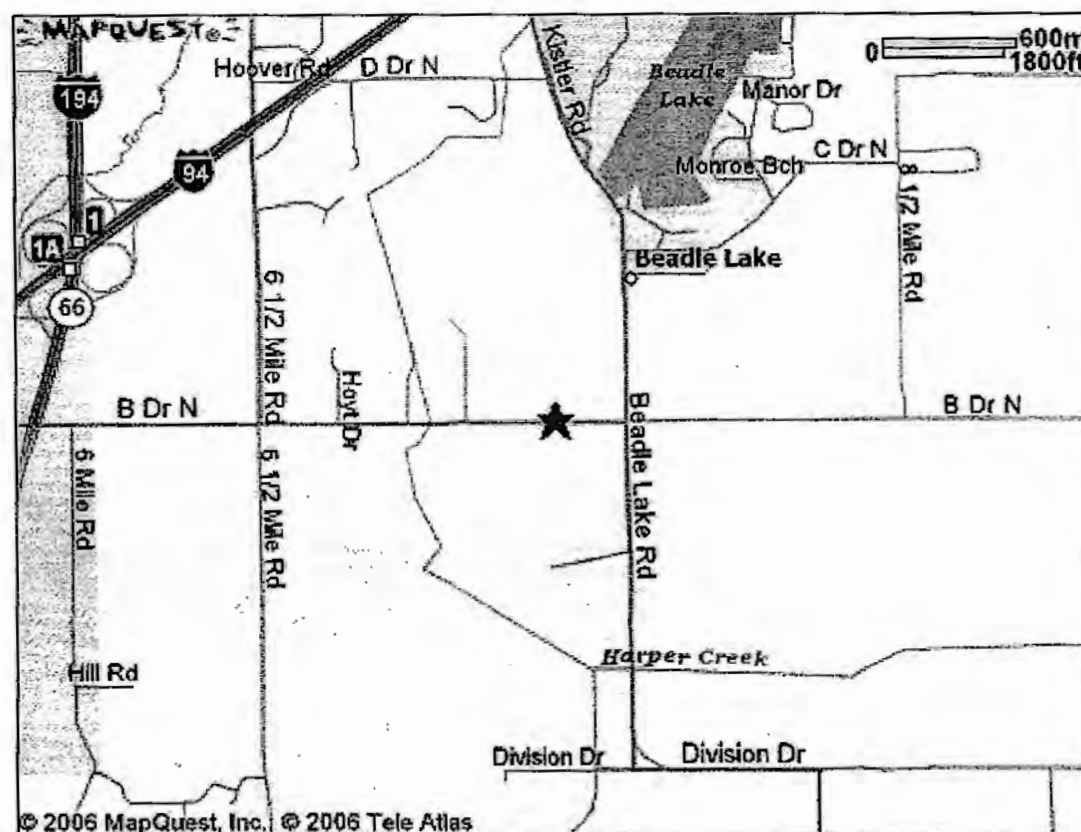

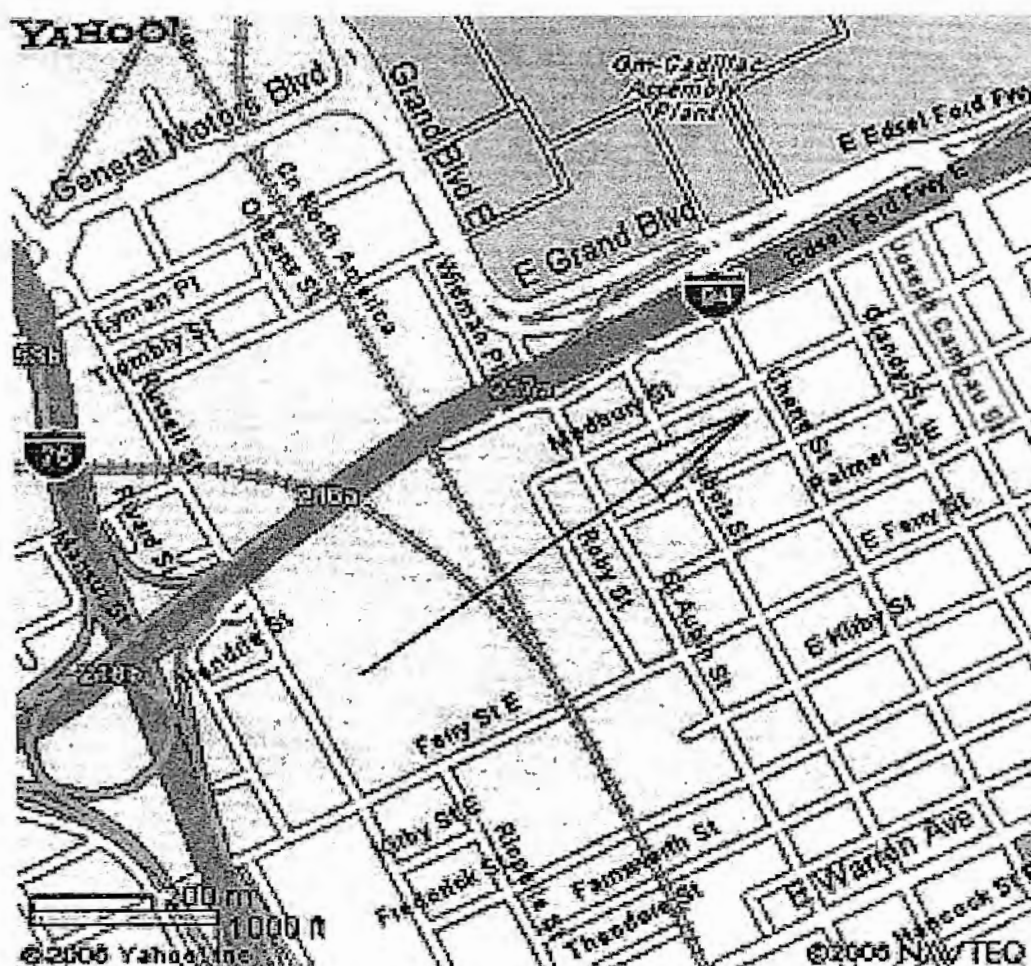

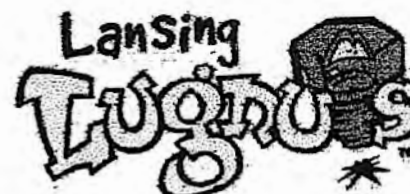
