# President's Page



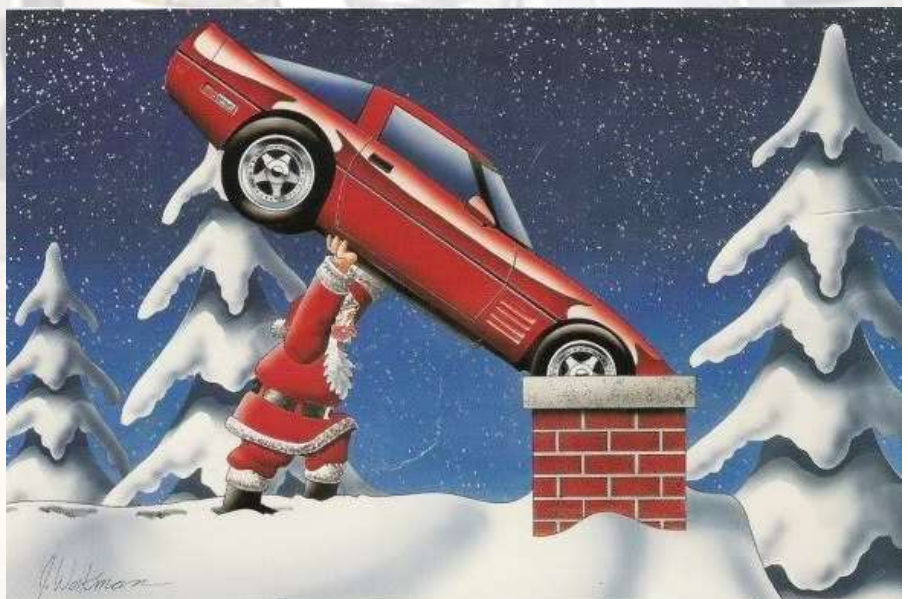
**Members,**
