

From the North:



Chevy Corvette Z06 Fetches \$3.6 Million At Auction

All of the proceeds will go to a charity for helping military families.

<u>Barrett-Jackson</u> has dropped the hammer on the first retail <u>2023 Chevrolet</u> <u>Corvette Z06</u>, fetching a whopping \$3.6 million. This is almost the most expensive Corvette sold at auction, if not for the 1967 Chevy Corvette L88 Coupe that got sold for \$3.85 million in 2014.

Unsurprisingly, the winning bid for the VIN001 2023 Corvette Z06 went to Rick Hendrick, founder and CEO of Hendrick Companies. Hendrick was also the winning bidder of the <u>first mid-engine Corvette Stingray in 2020</u>, with a hammer price of \$3 million.



The new 2023 Corvette Z06 is powered by a naturally aspirated 5.5-liter LT6 V8 with dual overhead camshafts and a flat-plane crankshaft, redlining at 8,600 rpm. It churns out up to 670 horsepower (500 kilowatts) and 460 pound-feet (623 Newton-meters).


