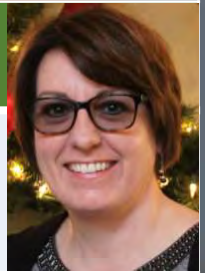

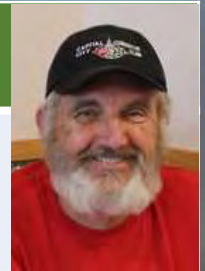

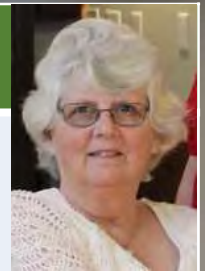

President's Page



Members,

I can't believe it is already March! Another COVID surge has passed, and the snow should be letting up soon. That means it is time to bring our Corvettes out of hibernation and start spring cleaning and some preventative maintenance to ensure a safe and enjoyable season. I mentioned in the fall that I am a "change the oil before storage" person. If you didn't change the oil before storage, now is the time. Regardless of mileage, contaminants build up and chemicals breakdown with age.

Before your first drive, you should give your Corvette an inspection and address any issues found. When evaluating your Corvette, you first should let the interior air out and remove anything you put in the car for rodent prevention, especially if you plugged your exhaust tips. Hopefully you either had your battery on a tender or removed from the car. Before your first start, make sure your battery has a full charge. While under the hood addressing the battery, check the belts and hoses for cracks. Verify fluid levels including your oil if you changed it in the fall. Have a look over any exposed wiring harness and check for any loose connections or cracks. Your tires will probably need some air added to bring them back up to safe pressure so, while you are checking the air in your tires, look under the car to inspect for any fluid leaks. Also, check the dates on the tires; Anything over 6 years old is considered dangerous. You are probably excited to hit the road at this point, but before you do start the car and let it idle for a bit to let everything get up to temperature and you can check vehicle functions. Verify the alternator is functioning and all lights are functional before leaving the driveway. Investing a little time at the start of the season can prevent some frustrating breakdowns during the year. Even if everything was functioning when parked in the Fall, after setting 4-5 months, conditions can change.

This month we will attempt to go back to in-person meetings. I hope this plan isn't met with another COVID surge or snowstorm. We will continue to have Zoom as an option, but I hope to see many of you at the membership meetings. You will most likely hear some discussion about Online Event Registration. This is a feature in the National Points Database that allows members to sign up for events with just their NCCC number and automatically populates the rest of the information. Not only is it quicker for the member registering for an event but it also helps the chairperson in verifying participant information and point calculations. It may be a little clunky at first, but we would like to see how it goes with a couple of events.

A final reminder this month. Registration for the National Convention in Atlantic City is now open. If you plan on going but have not registered, please complete registration as soon as possible. The earlier you register, the more control you have of your own schedule. My wife and I won't be able to attend this year, but we highly recommend attending if you can.

Capital City Corvette Club Turkey Award

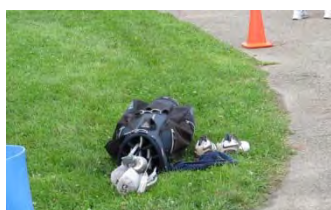

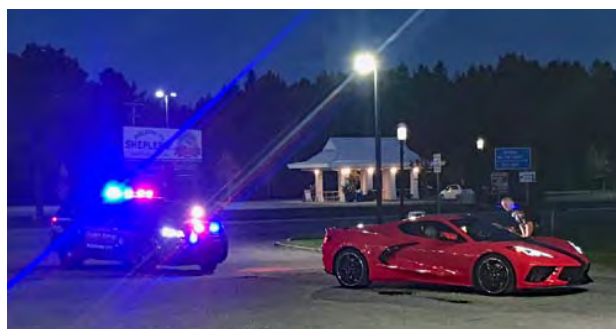

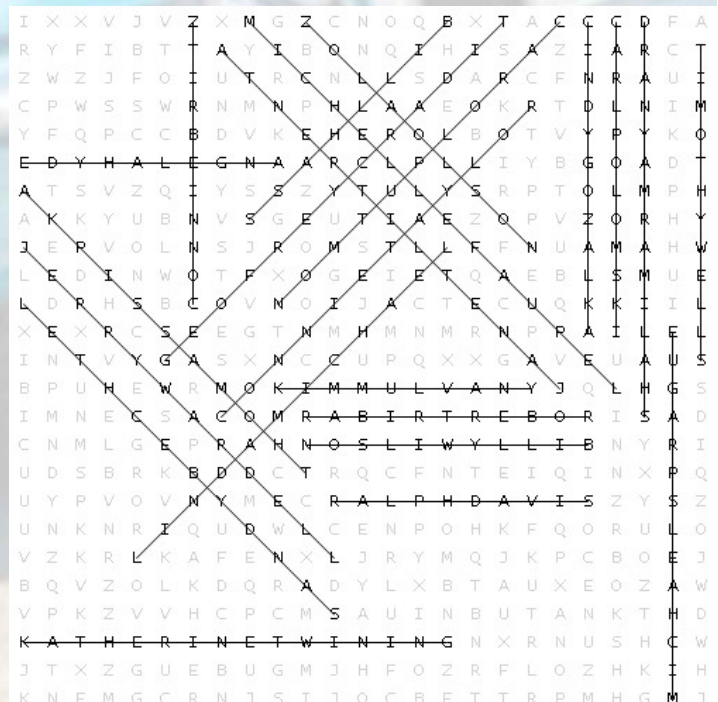
