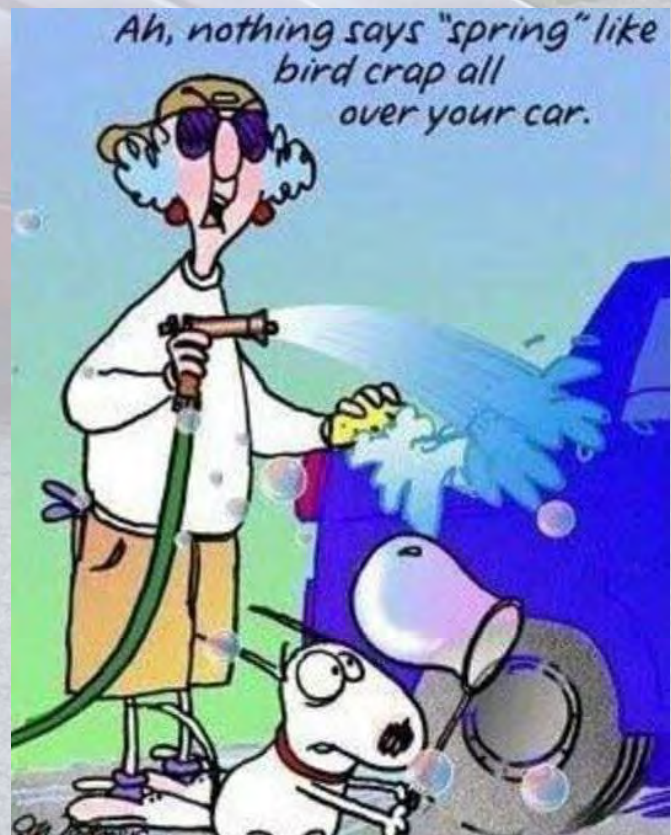
# Board Meeting Minutes
