Mr. Gilmore's Retirement

A person's hopes and dreams for their retirement are as varied as the people who make them. Mr. Gilmore did not have an automotive career or background, but when he retired in 1963, his wife gave him a 1920 Pierce Arrow that needed work.

Donald S. Gilmore was born in 1895 and raised in Kalamazoo MI. After high school he attended Yale Sheffield Scientific School in New Haven CT. He returned to Kalamazoo and joined his brothers, James and John, in operating the Gilmore Department Store that the family founded in 1888. In 1916, Donald married Genevieve Upjohn, the daughter of Dr. William Upjohn who had founded the Upjohn pharmaceutical company. Donald joined the Upjohn Company in 1929 and eventually became chairman.

After retiring and working on his Pierce Arrow, Gilmore began collecting more historic vehicles including a 1927 Ford Model T and a 1913 Rolls Royce. By 1966 he had acquired 45 vehicles and needed more space. He had purchased 90 acres in Hickory Corners because he felt it was strategically located between Detroit and Chicago. He proceeded to buy three historic Michigan barns that he had dismantled and reassembled on the property.

The Gilmore Car Museum opened to the public on July 31, 1966, and has become one of the largest automobile museums in the country. The collection includes over 400 vehicles in multiple restored barns and buildings. The property also features a 1940's diner, 1930's Shell gas station and recreated auto dealerships for Franklin, Model A Ford, Cadillac and Lincoln. The museum's mission is to tell the history of America through the automobile. Corvette enthusiasts have a special opportunity to enjoy this extensive collection during the Best of the Bowties event on July 20, 2025.

How to look up 4C and Michigan Region Events

If you scroll back up to the top of the page, it has links to the Michigan Region competition events. If you click on the link that says, "Event Flyers," this link takes you to the Michigan Region events page. Here is where you will find a multitude of events happening throughout the year in the Michigan Region. If you are interested in branching out and trying your hand at an Autocross, Funkhana, Rallye, or even a car show that another region club is hosting, this is the hotspot for information. Events are listed by Date and Event Type. Click on anything that is underlined in the event type column that you may be interested in, and it will take you to that events flyer where you will find more information on that event.

You never know what you will find to do during the Corvette season. A new favorite car show/cruise-in to attend, or you may decide to try an autocross, Funkhana, or Rallye and find out that you really like it. Heck.... When you branch out, you even make new friends. It is a WIN/WIN for sure!!


